Are you happy?

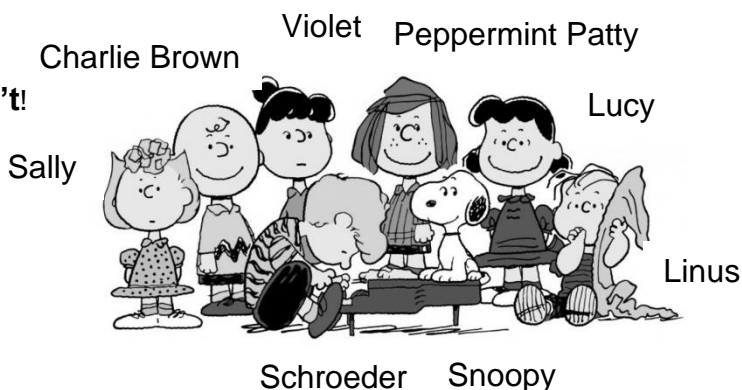

We celebrated their birthdays, too.

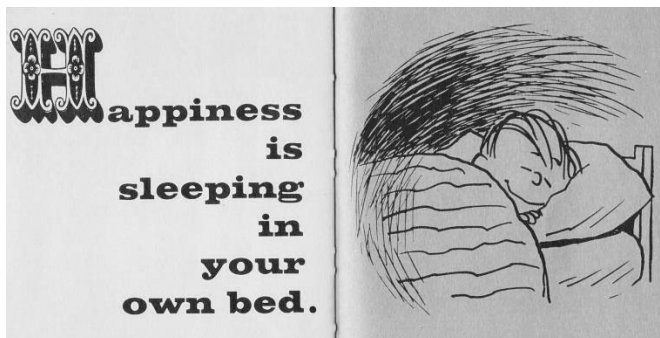
We visited Larry's mother and his sisters.
