I can't make it. – *Nem érek oda. (Nem érek rá.)*

Maybe some other time. – *Máskor esetleg/lehet.*

She's **out to lunch** today. (*buggyant, "nutty as a fruitcake"*)

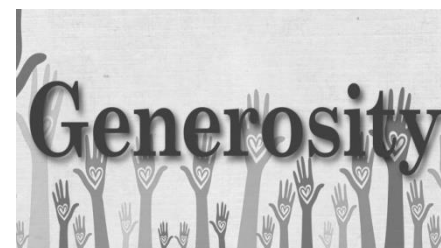
The children were **full of beans** after the party. (*eleven, mozgékony*)
