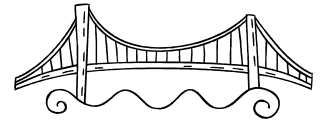

M - OK. Good-bye.

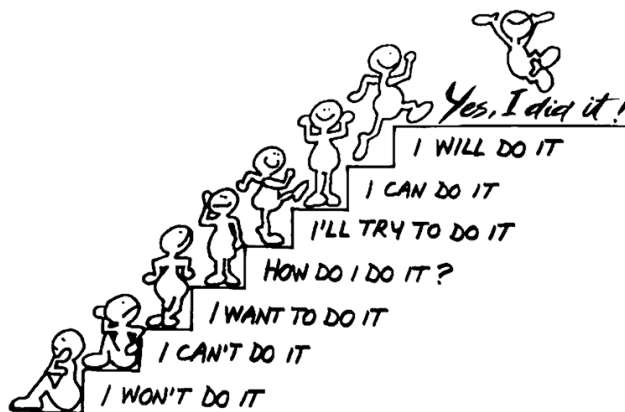
