Nyelc patkó - kop-kop-kop -

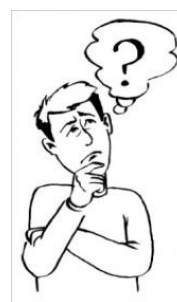
csönd-zsákból hangot lop.
